GOVERNOR BABAJIDE SANWO-OLU COMMISSIONS MEDICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS AT LASUTH

The Governor of Lagos State, Mr. Babajide Sanwo-Olu, represented by his Deputy, Dr. Obafemi Hamzat, commissioned medical infrastructure projects at the Lagos State University Teaching Hospital (LASUTH). The commissioned projects include a 124-Bed Sustainable Development Goal Multipurpose Medical Building; the Renovated House Officers' Quarters; an Ambulance Bay; and a Special Services Centre. He also broke the ground for the commencement of construction of Doctors' Resident Quarters.

The Deputy Governor of Lagos State, Dr. Obafemi Hamzat, speaking on behalf of Mr. Governor, stated that "the delivery of the modern medical infrastructure projects will further strengthen the capacity of the State health care system to meet the needs of residents and citizens alike." Governor Sanwo-Olu, appreciated the Senior Special Assistant to the President on Sustainable Development Goals, Princess Adejoke Orelope-Adefulire for the donation of the 124-bed SDG multipurpose medical building to Lagos State. He said, the purpose built medical infrastructure will significantly raise the status of LASUTH as a leading healthcare institution.

MEDICAL... UNVEILS MODERN MEDICAL INFRASTRUCTURAL PROJECTS

The Chief Medical Director of Lagos State University Teaching Hospital, (LASUTH), Prof. Adetokunbo. O Fabamwo affirmed that the hospital is now better equipped to accommodate more patients, thereby, reducing medical tourism. He stated this during a media parley held on Wednesday, 31st of May, 2023.

Prof. Fabamwo has affirmed that the hospital has witnessed impressive medical infrastructural transformation in recent time, saying that LASUTH is continuing in its efforts at being at the forefront of healthcare delivery in Nigeria.

He spoke about a Multipurpose Medical Building recently donated by the Senior Special Assistant to President Mohammed Buhari, on Sustainable Development Goal (SDG), to the hospital and also recently commissioned for use by Mr. Governor, Babajide Olusola Sanwo-Olu, describing the building as well equipped with modern medical care facilities which comprises of 4 medical schools in the areas of Anaesthesia Technology, Echo Cardiograph, Orthopaedic Cast Technology and Post Graduate Nursing, also houses the Family Medicine Department, Dietetics Department, Managed Care Unit, Immunization Clinic, private wards, super executive private wards, 20 bed Intensive Care Unit, a Spa and a Gym, amongst others. "This facility will significantly raise the status of LASUTH as a leading Centre of excellence in healthcare service delivery", he said.

He spoke highly of the Special Services Special Services Centre (SSC), which is intended to bridge the gap in the healthcare sector and solve challenges of interventional procedures. He said that the SSC accommodates a Dialysis Unit, a Bronchoscopy Suite, a Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory and an Endoscopy Suite.

Maintaining a healthy lifestyle as a license to keeping a clean bill of health cannot be overemphasized and the Lifestyle Medicine and Wellness Unit of the Department of Family Medicine at the Lagos State University Teaching Hospital (LASUTH) recently brought this discussion to fore. This was done at the commemoration of the 2023 Global Lifestyle Medicine Week tagged 'Beat the Root Cause of Diseases with D.R.E.A.M.S'.

The Chief Medical Director of LASUTH, Prof. Adetokunbo O. Fabamwo while delivering the welcome speech at a webinar, harped on the need for medical practitioners to further propagate the benefits of healthy lifestyle. He opined that many people are privy to the know-how on the requirements of healthy living but most fail to practice them and that, he says, is where the problem lies. 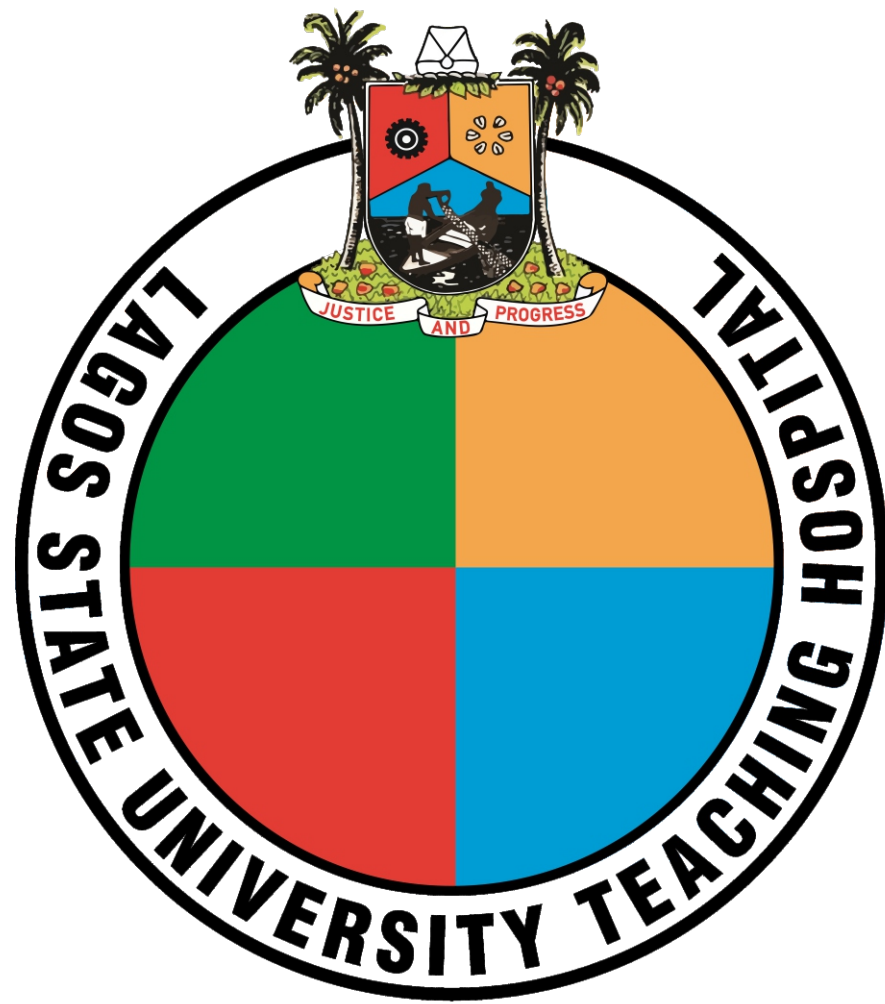

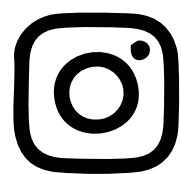
